3 Safety and Traffic Reminders

Safety and physical development information may be found in the student planner. Parents are encouraged to reinforce the key points with your child/ward such as road safety and safe bus rides.

To ensure orderly dismissal, we appeal to parents/ guardians/ care-givers not to obstruct student movement, and to practice distancing when waiting outside all the school gates. We would also appreciate if you could train your child/ward to look out for the right person to accompany him/her home and not to follow strangers or their friends. If your child is unable to find his/her care-giver during dismissal, he/she should go the General Office for assistance.

We also appeal to parents to note the following:

Morning drop-off

We thank parents who drive into school for ensuring that your child is ready for drop-off in the mornings when you drive into school. Their bags should be with them and they are ready to alight on their own. So far we have been able to clear the queue by 7.29 a.m. Please be reminded that the peak period starts from 7.10 a.m. when the waiting time to drop-off will typically be longer.

School dismissal pick-up

For those who drive, please be reminded not to park your cars at the school gates or along the double yellow lines just outside school at all times. Cars are allowed into the school after the school buses leave at 1.45 p.m. If you are driving and need to pick up your child earlier than 1.45 p.m., please arrange to pick them from the roundabout near Block 511.

No-waiting at school porch/pick-up zone

Please be informed that waiting at the Drop-Off zone within the school compound is strictly not allowed for the safety of students and staff. If you arrive earlier than the pick-up time, please wait at the available lots in the car-park. You can drive up to the porch to pick your child up when he/she is ready.

1 SwimSafer[™] 2.0 Programme

Swimming is a useful skill which develops strength and flexibility, increases stamina and even improves balance and posture. Children can swim to keep themselves fit and healthy. Being able to swim also allows children to participate in other water sports in the future.

The SwimSaferTM 2.0 programme teaches children to be water-safe and acquire life-long swimming skills. The ability to swim is a learning outcome in the Physical Education Primary Syllabus.
