Direct Schools Admission (DSA) Applicants

Students admitted to a school through the DSA-Sec exercise are

- expected to honour their commitment to their posted DSA-Sec schools, &
- NOT allowed to make any school choices during S1 Option Phase and not allowed to transfer to another school after the release of the PSLE results.



PSLE Result Slip & Certificate

- Check your result slip and PSLE certificate to ensure that your personal particulars (such as statutory names and Hanyu Pinyin names) are printed correctly.
- If there is any error, inform the Form Teachers **immediately**.



Third Language Eligibility

- Students who are eligible to take a third language will **receive an eligibility letter** with the release of PSLE results.



Appeal for Review of Results

- Parents may appeal for a review of the results for the marking of the scripts to be rechecked.
- All appeal for review of results must be made through the Principal.
- An appeal fee will be charged for each subject and appeal application must reach SEAB within 5 working days from the release of the PSLE results.



Selection of Secondary Schools

Parents should consider the following factors:

- Distance from home
- Learning environment that suits their children (e.g. similar academic ability, programmes offered, ALP/LLP, CCAs, etc.)

Note: Previous year's posting AL score range of schools serve only as a guide.

Selection of Secondary Schools

S1 Option – Through Internet System

- Can be completed through the **Secondary One Internet System (S1-IS)** in MOE's S1 Posting website
- The S1-IS is **accessible 24 hours a day** within the **online submission period** of

**11.30 am, 20 Nov 2024
to 3pm, 26 Nov 2024**

Posting Results

- Will be released between **Wednesday, 18 December 2024 and Friday, 20 December 2024**
- Students can check through:
 1. **SMS** via a local mobile number (if provided during the application/option process)
 2. **Secondary One Internet System**
 3. **EPPS** from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm



Sec 1 Posting

Reporting to Sec School

- **Do not** need to report to the secondary school you are posted to.
- Visit the Secondary School's website for more information (e.g reporting details, booklist, and purchase of books and uniforms)



Development of Talent in Art & Music

- 4-year **Art Elective Programme (AEP)** and **Music Elective Programme (MEP)** offered to students enrolled in AEP/MEP Schools leading to Higher Art/Music at GCE O-Level
- Students not posted to AEP/MEP schools may apply as external students
- Submit application through their secondary schools in January 2025
- Details on application procedure available on MOE AEP/MEP websites



Non-Participating Specialised Schools for Students

NUS High School (NUSHS),
School of the Arts (SOTA),
School of Science and Technology (SST),
Singapore Sports School (SSP)

- NUSSH, SOTA, SST and SSP **do not take part in the S1 Posting Exercise.**
- As such, students will **not** be able to indicate these schools as any of their choices.
- Students who have applied to SSP are required to participate in the S1 Posting Exercise as well.



Specialised Schools for Normal (Technical) Students

**Crest Secondary School (CSS) &
Spectra Secondary School (SSS)**

- Both CSS and SSS **do not take part in the S1 Posting Exercise.**
- Eligible and interested students can **submit hardcopy application directly** to CSS and/or SSS
- Students who have applied to CSS and/or SSS will also **need to participate in the S1 Posting Exercise** to opt for their other school choices.
